

Application Instructions for St. Benedict Catholic School

Tuition Assistance Program

St. Benedict Tuition Assistance Program is offered to families of students in K-5 kindergarten through 8th grade. It encompasses several forms of tuition assistance with several awarding benefactors. Those applicants who file an annual tax form 1040 must complete a FACTS application and the Pastoral/Principal Tuition Assistance Form in order to be considered for tuition assistance and grants. Those applicants, who do not file an annual Tax Form 1040, must complete the Pastoral/Principal Tuition Assistance Form and set up an appointment with their parish priest in order to be considered.

- Complete **FACTS Aid Application** <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3VHND>.
March 16th- April 30th for the following school year, using the link "Parents - Applying for Financial Aid" button on the home page. Current tax form 1040 and a small processing fee is required at the time of the application. Completion of this step is a prerequisite to completing Pastoral/Principal Tuition Assistance form described below. Applicants not having access to a computer should make arrangements with St. Benedict Catholic School Secretary for use of one on campus.
- Obtain the **Pastoral/Principal Financial Aid Form** from St. Benedict Catholic website. Complete the form by **May 15th** for the following school year, with your personal information and have your parish priest sign it.

- Apply for **KREMER FOUNDATION GRANT**-Form available from SBCS website. Return the **Parent Application** form and the first two pages of 2019 tax form 1040 or other acceptable forms of income substantiation listed on our website to the SBCS office by **May 15th**
