THE CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS PROTECTION PROGRAM (CAPP)

- All faculty, staff, and volunteers are required to be annually trained in The Children and Adolescents Protection Program (CAPP)
- This includes classroom volunteers, field trip drivers, coaches for any sports including cheerleading
- Initial training classes take place the second Tuesday of each month, starting at 7:00 PM at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Fairhope. Pre-registration is required to attend the initial training classes.

ATTENDANCE

- Research has shown that your child's regular attendance may be the greatest factor influencing his/her academic success. By attending class regularly, your child is more likely to keep up with daily lessons and assignments and take quizzes and tests on time.
