What are the advantages of intramural sports?

When is soccer season and when will practices be held?

- Soccer Season Dates: September 16 - October 31

When is flag football and when will practices be held?

- Flag Football Season Dates: November 4 - November 22

Who may participate in flag football?

- Any St. Benedict Catholic School student in 5th through 8th grade who would like to participate in the Turkey Bowl.
